For many students, this is the time in the year when either they, a teacher, or a parent/guardian recognizes the need for additional academic support. **Bellingham High School** offers a range of such supports for students that demonstrate this need:

- The first contact should be student to teacher. Many teachers have days they are available either before or after school to work individually with students. Students should contact their teacher to schedule a time to meet.
- **Bellingham High Library is open until 3:45. This space has computers and offers collaborative areas for students to work.**
- Raiderade, a student support system that happens twice weekly, is also a time that students can work with teachers, tutors or mentors for additional help. Students can work in their Raiderade rooms or make arrangements with their teachers to meet with other teachers or in study groups with other students.
- **BHS Study Center runs Monday-Thursday 3:15-4:15 in Computer Lab 203. There are staff and WWU tutors available daily to help, with extra tutoring for science on Mondays, and English on Thursdays. The staff provides snacks and bus passes for students who attend.**
- BHS has two Student Success Coordinators, Karanbir Deol and Michelle Strobel, who support students with their individual needs.
- **For first generation college students, the AVID program is available on an application basis. AVID classes support students with study skills and college readiness.**
- BHS also offers academic support classes to students who would like to have a period during the class day when they can work on and get support with classwork.

If your Red Raider has utilized these resources and is still struggling with their classes, please reach out to your student’s teachers and their assigned counselor if you have not already. We welcome the opportunity to partner with students and families to help every student find success at BHS.
