Is in the final academic year (senior year) of her secondary education. Has a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0. Is a citizen or legal permanent resident of the US or Canada. Plans to attend an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the US or Canada, full-time or part-time, in the fall of the academic year following high school graduation. Is recommended by and receives the vote of a local P.E.O. chapter

Procedures: Submission of the chapter recommendation form and chapter recommendation letter (thoroughly introducing the applicant and explaining her outstanding qualities and achievements) must be made online between September 1 and November 1.
