Deadline: 10/31/2018 Amount: \$1,000 - \$30,000

Voice of Democracy VFW

Eligibility: Grades 9-12: Audio essay contest for students planning on attending an American university, college or vocational/technical school. Each states winner receives a trip to Washington D.C.

Procedures: Students record their 3-5 minute essay onto an audio CD or flash drive. The theme this year is: "My Responsibility to America" Judging is based on originality, content and delivery. See website for complete details and instructions.

Eligibility: SENIOR: U.S. Citizen, U.S. National, U.S. Permanent Resident. Minimum 3.0 GPA, demonstrating Academic Achievement, Leadership, Community Activities

Procedures: A general scholarship. Apply on-line at www.coca-colascholars.org. Online application required. 150 scholars will be awarded \$20,000 scholarships. Applicants can be planning to attend 2 or 4 year colleges/university.

Eligibility: SENIOR: Latinx students who demonstrate advocacy, accountability, perseverance and have shown a commitment to improving their community. Open to any student regardless of citizenship status.

Eligibility: SENIOR, attending high school in Comcast Community, demonstrating commitment to community service outstanding qualities in character, integrity and leadership. min. 3.0 GPA Planning to attend college, university, vocational or technical college for the next school year.

AXA Achievement Community Scholarship

Eligibility: SENIOR, US citizen or legal resident. The more applicants the more chances of winning! Plan of full time enrollment in a 2 or 4-year college/university in the fall after graduation.

Procedures: Must be ambitious and motivated, as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community, or work activities, and be recommended by an unrelated adult who can attest to the student's achievement. Applicants will describe an outstanding long-term achievement they have accomplished in a non-academic activity or project. Only 10,000 applications will be accepted.

AXA Achievement Scholarship - U.S. News & World Report

Eligibility: SENIOR, demonstrated ambition and self-drive as evidenced by an outstanding achievement in an activity in school, the community, or the workplace. One senior selected from each state. Must be US citizens or legal residents.

Procedures: Comprehensive application. In addition to listing of activities, awards, etc., applicants are asked to describe in detail an outstanding achievement they have accomplished in a non-academic activity or project. See application for details. For every student who wins a scholarship a \$1,000 grant will be awarded to their high school.

Dirk Derrick Car & Truck Accident Injury Scholarship

Whatcom County Student Athlete Scholarship-Todd Curran Memorial

Eligibility: SENIOR, Academic Achievement (3.0), Community Service, and Sports Activity.

Procedures: Application in Career Center. Recommendations, copy of transcript, completed application. One girl and one boy selected from all of Whatcom County. The two scholarships awarded are in the amount of \$8,000 (\$2,000 per year for four years).

Deadline: 1/4/2019 Amount: \$10,000 renewable

GE-Reagan Foundation

Eligibility: SENIOR: plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study toward a bachelor's degree at an accredited four-year college or university in the United States for the entire upcoming academic year. Must demonstrate at school, at the workplace, and within the community the attributes of leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; (minimum 3.0 grade point average/4.0 scale or equivalent) US Citizen

Procedures: Semifinalists will be required to provide a recommendation from a community leader, such as a high school principal, elected official or executive director of a nonprofit organization, and must provide documentation to certify academic performance and financial need.

Coolidge Scholars Program

Eligibility: JUNIOR: The Coolidge Scholarship is an annually awarded, full-ride, presidential scholarship that covers a student's tuition, room, board, and expenses for four years of undergraduate study. The Coolidge may be used by recipients at any accredited American college or university. Anyone of any background, pursuing any academic discipline of study, may apply to this non-partisan, need-blind, program

Procedures: All application materials, including the two letters of recommendation, must be received by the deadline. Please take special note of the time zone

Firefighter Jason Karwhite Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: SENIOR: This scholarship is for students who are entering the emergency medical field, medical field, fire sciences or fire service. Preference is given to students who are related to a current member in good standing of IAFF(International Association of Fire Fighters) L10

Procedures: 2 letters of recommendation required, short paragraph answers to questions regarding planned career field, career goals, interests out of school, special skills and talents and why you should be selected for this scholarship. Official high school transcript required.

Deadline: 2/11/2019 Amount: \$1,500 (x 2yrs)

Fair Chance Scholarship

Eligibility: SENIOR: planning on attending an accredited two or four year college, university or trade/technical school. Must be currently working, volunteering or involved in a school-sponsored activity. Min. 2.7 GPA required. Prior involvement with the Fair (4-H, FFA, etc.) and financial need may be considered but not required.

Procedures: Complete application form online. The \$3,000 awards are payable over two years (\$1,500 each year). All funds are paid directly to the recipient's college or university to be used toward tuition or books.

Anderson Criminal Justice Scholarship

Eligibility: SENIOR: planning to attend an accredited two year or four year college or university in Washington state that offers a Criminal Justice program. Preference will be given to students pursuing a career in law enforcement.

Procedures: Complete the application and include unofficial transcript and two letters of recommendation. Scholarship is renewable for another \$2500 if student is in a Criminal Justice program.

Ewing C. Kelly Scholarship

Eligibility: SENIOR: Designed to reward students who demonstrate good citizenship while striving to attain their academic goals. Judged on academic merit, extra-curricular achievements-both scholastically and in the community. Applicant must be accepted, or have an application pending, at an accredited institution of higher learning, public or private, including community college. If planning on a 4-yr college must have a composite score or 20 on the ACT or a composite score of 1030 on SAT. Must be a US citizen or have green card.

Procedures: This is a general scholarship that can be used at any 2 or 4-yr. College. Application is on-line or in hardcopy available from the Career Center. Last year over 500 applications were judged and 52 awards were given!
