## THE PSAT EXAM FOR JUNIORS IS OCTOBER 10TH

On **Wednesday, October 10<sup>th</sup>**, BHS will administer the PSAT exam to 11<sup>th</sup> grade students. The PSAT is a test of the skills and knowledge essential for college and career that students are learning in class. It offers students an opportunity to connect with colleges and universities, enter scholarship competitions, get ready for the SAT exam, and sharpen their skills with free practice on Khan Academy.

The PSAT is scheduled from 8:30am-12pm. Students should check the assessment bulletin board in the commons for their test locations, and bring a calculator with them on test day. The PSAT Student Guide, which includes the practice test, is available in Student Services.
